He told me alcoholism was in both sides of his family and that he really does not want to go down that path. We talked about blackouts and the progression of the disease. I shared with him that as long as I drank I got worse, never better. He was interested and we talked for quite some time. He eagerly took a couple of pamphlets and said he would read them. I told him about a Speakers Meeting tomorrow at noon, I hope to see him there.

June 10, 2018

Matt N., gave the Secretary's report. The minutes were provided and e-mailed out to the delegates. A motion was made to approve the minutes and was seconded. The minutes were approved by vote.

Art S., gave the Treasurer's Report for May 2018. The total Income for April was \$ 10,011.24, less Expenses of \$ 12,440.15 leaving a net loss of \$ 2,428.91. It was mentioned that this loss is expected right now. The summer months are always a little slow and group contributions have continued to be down. Teresa mentioned that June may also be in the red, while final monies are paid out, but that she expects July to be an amazing month. She recognizes that a monthly loss like this can sound alarming, but it should be noted that our prudent reserve is well intact and the office as a whole is well in the black. She noted that an article from the Central Office accountant has been posted along with the itemized bank account information. Art S. further mentioned that the Central Office is in point of fact a 501c-3 organization and by definition not for profit as well.

Derrick., gave the Board Report for May 2018. He mentioned that the new website is beautiful and quite beautiful. It is also super user friendly to both computer users as well as mobile users. He mentioned that the financial losses for the month were expected due to paying for the new website. He also mentioned that Art S. is the new Kansas Lesion.

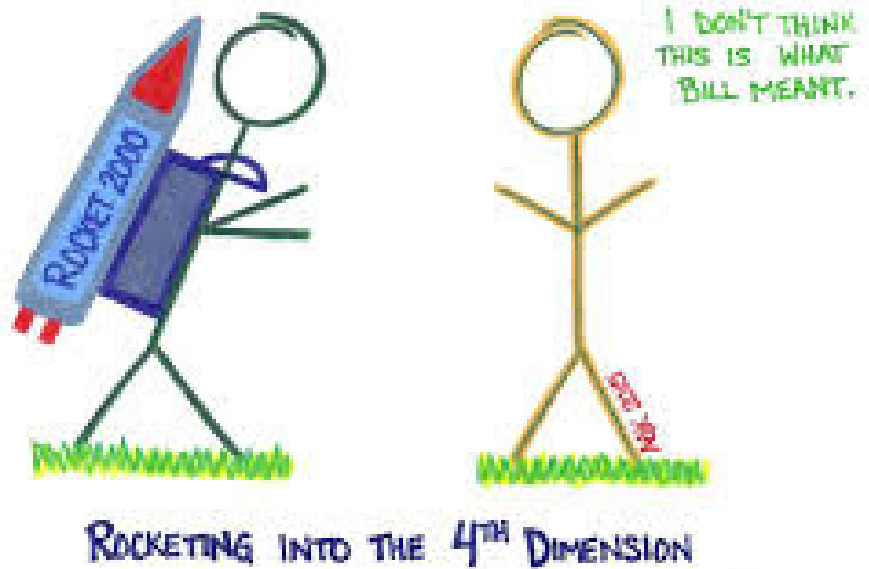
